

## **Required items for a PA Dune Buggy Title**

## A Dune Buggy receives a "Specially Constructed" branded title

## Dune Buggies must meet all regulations listed in Subchapter E of the vehicle

<u>code</u>

\*\*\*Link to code book is on enhanced inspection page

- Bill of sale (if purchasing, already built, etc.)
- Certificate of Title, Certificate of Salvage or Certificate of Origin

(If you have one from the chassis you used this documentation is not required, except you need to show where you came up with all of the parts used. The state will issue a new VIN with or without a title)

- Copy of <u>all</u> receipts (from building it or for any modifications made since it was purchased)
- **Explanation Build Sheet** on 8-1/2"x11" sheet of paper (*Explaining in easy terms, body type, frame type, engine type, suspension type, etc. and how/who assembled*)
- **Optional Explanation Sheet** Used to explain if you do not have documentation or receipts for all parts. If you do not have receipts for some parts, you need to explain why. You will need to pay sales tax on an estimated value of those parts. The state has the right to deny accepting this but they are normally fairly reasonable if explanation is reasonable.

## Commonly Missed Items

- Windshield height (not less than 12" in vertical height)
- Must have a windshield wiper
- Must have a defrost system (may be clip on unit, JC Whitney sells one)
- Fuel tank must be an approved tank (see section 175.80 of Vehicle code, cannot be a self-fabricated tank)
- Fuel tank and lines cannot be in or pass through passenger area or cargo area (see section 175.80 of vehicle code)
- Fuel filter must be externally mounted
- Glass needs to be of approved type for area (Safety glass all areas and *laminated for windshield etc.*)
- Window tint must meet same criteria as standard regulation (\*\*See link on enhanced page for window screening regulations)
- $\circ$   $\,$   $\,$  Fan shroud must be covering fan so hands cannot get in fan if engine is not totally covered  $\,$
- Mufflers (see section 175.75 of vehicle code)
- Scrub line (see section 175.209 of vehicle code)
- Obstructions forward of the windshield (e.g. hood scoops, etc. cannot project upward more than 2" from the bottom of the drivers line of sight)
- Minimum of 1 mirror is required
- Tire width (the front tires have a minimum width of 5". The rear tires cannot be wider than 9" unless a dual cylinder master cylinder brake system is used)
- Dune Buggies must have bumpers front and back
- Dune Buggies must have fenders that exceed beyond the tire tread
- Dune Buggies must have the entire engine covered by a hood (see section 175.77.c of vehicle code)
